Issue of Certificate of Airworthiness

1. A Sudanese Certificate of Airworthiness is issued on the bases of Export Certificate of Airworthiness issued by the Airworthiness Authority of the Country of Manufacture, or the Airworthiness Authority of the Country of Export.
 - 1.1 The possession of an Export Certificate of airworthiness should not be taken as an indication of automatic issue of a Sudanese Certificate of Airworthiness
 - 1.2 The requirements for the issue of a Sudanese Certificate of airworthiness, which must be complied with, are depicted in ANR Part III Sub part 6.
 - 1.3 In the case of aircraft intended for Public Transport or Aerial Work, a Technical log book to the requirements of the Air Navigation Regulations and ANR part IV.
 - 1.4 Also in the case of aircraft being the first of the type on the Sudan Register, the applicant will be required to deposit with the Directorate all Technical Documents and Certificates as specified in ANR. In relation to this Notice see also CAA Air worthiness Notice NOs...8, 11, 12 and in the case of imported second hand aircraft- Notice No. 13.
2. **CANCELLATION:- This Notice cancels all previous issues of notice No. 10 which should be destroyed.**
