Change In Aircraft Registration Particulars

1. Many instances have occurred whereby owners of aircraft have failed to notify the Director of Civil Aviation Authority of
 - a) Changes in the ownership of aircraft.
 - b) Changes in the nationality qualification for ownership and,
 - c) The destruction or permanent withdrawal from use of an aircraft.
2. The attention of all concerned is therefore drawn to the fact that failure to notify the Director of Civil Aviation Authority of any change in the registration status of an aircraft is in contravention of the Sudan Air Navigation Regulations 2004 in part II.01.
3. It is therefore emphasized that all owners and operators must notify the Director General of Civil Aviation Authority, on the prescribed form, of any change pertaining to the status of any aircraft appearing on the Sudan Civil Aircraft Register as soon as such change occurs.

It is also stressed that when an aircraft is destroyed, withdrawn from use, permanently leaves to the other country, or in any other way becomes ineligible for registration in the Sudan, the appropriate section on the back of the Registration certificate shall immediately be completed and returned to the Civil Aviation Authority for appropriate action.
4. **CANCELLATION:- This notice cancels all previous issues of notice No. 12 which should be destroyed.**
