### **Aircraft Weight and Centre of Gravity Schedules**

The legal requirements for aircraft weighing and the production of the Centre of Gravity Schedule are contained in Air Navigation Regulations 2000 and ANR part.

#### **Weight and Centre of Gravity Schedule:**

On completion of aircraft weighing or subsequent reweighing, a copy of the Weight and Centre of gravity Schedule shall be duly certified by approved person or an approved organisation in the case of large transport aircraft and submitted to the Office of the Director of Air worthiness, Civil Aviation Authority for approval. Copies of previous weighing reports shall be retained for a period of not less than six months.

The weight and Centre of Gravity Schedule shall contain the following statement:

“in compliance with Sudan Air Navigation Act Chapter 3 Article 34 it is the responsibility of the aircraft commander to ensure before flight that the load is of such a weight, as distributed and secured in a manner that it is safe for the intended flight” .
