### The Maintenance of Aircraft Used for Aerial Spraying Purposes

1. Because of the highly corrosive effect of certain chemicals now in common use for aerial crop spraying and dusting, attention is drawn to the need for special care in the maintenance of aircraft used for this purpose.
2. This Directorate has decided that in respect of aircraft used for public transport duties, as well as for aerial work, the approved maintenance schedules must include the additional maintenance which is necessary before public transport duties are re-commenced following a period of aerial flying. These additional maintenance checks will be mandatory and must be undertaken irrespective of the fact that the aircraft may not be due for inspection against the normal basic check cycle.

This Directorate agrees that Certificate of Airworthiness of aircraft currently on the Sudanese Register and engaged on agricultural operations may not be renewed unless evidence is available that maintenance has been carried out in accordance with the above mentioned requirements.

3. **CANCELLATION:- This issue cancels all previous issues of Notice No. 24 which should be destroyed.**
