



AIRWORTHINESS NOTICE

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Sudan Approval of Foreign Maintenance Organization

1. The maintenance of aircraft which is can not be performed in the Sudan will be in accordance with appropriate maintenance arrangements agreed by the Airworthiness Directorate of the Sudan Civil Aviation Authority. Changes to the agreed maintenance arrangements will be by prior permissions of the Air worthiness Directorate of the Sudan Civil Aviation Authority.
2. The Sudan Operators who require to have maintenance carried out by Foreign Maintenance Organizations must apply directly to the Airworthiness Directorate of the Sudan Civil Aviation Authority .Applications received from Foreign Maintenance Organisations who are subcontracted to carry out maintenance on The Sudan Civil Registered aircraft **will not be accepted**.
3. The maintenance organisation will be expected to provide qualifications of senior personnel, details of company facilities and any existing approvals which may be held. Provided the approval fee is paid, a survey will be carried out by a Surveyor(s) of the Civil Aviation Authority -Airworthiness Directorate in accordance with ANR Part V or VI.
4. The Foreign maintenance organisation will be responsible for all the costs relating to the survey, including visas, first class air ticket, first class hotel accommodation, transportation from hotel to facility and airport, perdiem calculated from the date of departure until date of arrival to Khartoum.

The approval fee will be in accordance with the Sudan Scale of charges as amended.

5. The Sudan operators who require the temporary approval of a foreign maintenance organisation are responsible for the Sudan Civil Aviation Authority charges.
6. **CANCELLATION:- This issue cancels all previous issues of Notice No. 31 which should be destroyed.**
