**Use of Privately Owned Aircraft for Occasional Charter Operations**

1. Your attention is drawn to the practice whereby some charter operators are using privately owned aircraft from time to time to supplement their own fleet.
2. Aircraft so used, must before use, be assessed by the (Chief or Senior Engineer of the Operator concerned, to see at what position within the check cycle of the relevant Approved Maintenance Schedule the aircraft shall be placed.
3. The assessment shall be submitted for the approval of the Director of Airworthiness. Any conditions – and or work requirement will be advised by the Director of Airworthiness. The subject Aircraft shall not commence any commercial operation prior to the grant of the Director's approval.
4. Owners and Operators are reminded that aircraft to be used as above must have Certificate of Airworthiness in the Transport Category and a Certificate of Release to Service must be issued, after complying with the relevant approved Maintenance Schedule as applicable.
5. **CANCELLATION:- This notice cancels all previous issues of notice No. 9 which should be destroyed.**
